

DENNIS RESERVE MASTERPLAN IMPLEMENTATION

PROJECT UPDATE AUGUST 2020

Stage 1: Demolition of the former Williamstown Ladies Bowls Club, the Williamstown Central Tennis Pavilion and the construction of tennis courts

Demolition has recommenced onsite after some slight delays due to the removal of utilities to the site including the light pole, electrical services and an unexpected gas line. As part of the demolition works, six trees will also be removed as indicated in the approved master plan for the site. Works to the new tennis courts will commence after the demolition is complete.

The new tennis courts are expected to be completed in November 2020.

Stage 2: Open Space upgrades to the southern end of the reserve

Following community consultation in late 2019, the final concept plan includes a new playground, central passive area, new pathways through reserve and improved or additional landscaping at the southern end of the reserve.

Construction works are expected to commence in February 2021.

Stage 3: Construction of a new multipurpose community facility in the northern end of the reserve

Design development is scheduled to commence in November 2020 and a project working group will be established to guide the design. Further information will be provided closer to the time.
