Small deciduous upright vase-shaped tree becoming rounded with age

CHARACTERISTICS

- Oval leaves, striking autumn colour.
- Smooth, ornamental bark on multi-trunked tree.
- Panicles of medium-tohot-pink flowers.

Moderate to high drought tolerance

India, Burma, South China, Korea.



Known for its brilliant floral displays in late summer through to autumn. Different varieties bloom in shades of pink, purple, mauve, carmine, red and white.
