## DESCRIPTION

#### Typical height:

10-12 metres

#### Typical width:

6-10 metres

#### **Growth rate:**

Moderate to fast

#### Typical form:

Medium tree sized tree with round headed to pyramidal form. Dense evergreen canopy.

## **ORIGIN**

Coastal forests from northern NSW to north Queensland.

# CHARACTERISTICS

- Foliage dark green, and glossy.
- Smooth orange to brown bark.
- Cream flowers in spring.

## **TOLERANCES**

• Moderate tolerance to waterlogging, wind and pollution.

# FACTS AND TRIVIA

Sometimes mistaken for eucalypts, 'Lophostemon' is an entirely different genus of trees. They can be easily distinguished by not having eucalyptus-scented leaves when crushed, and also by the peculiar fuzzy bundles of stamens arranged on its five-petalled white flowers.
