Typical height:

10-12 metres

Typical width:

ORIGIN

Native to eastern Asia.

CHARACTERISTICS

- Small, glossy, dark green leaves.
- Orange-brown flaking bark.

TOLERANCES

- High drought and frost tolerance.
- Tolerates compaction and a restricted root zone.

FACTS AND TRIVIA

Unaffected by Elm Leaf Beetle.

Wind pollinated and wind-dispersed with samaras that gain distance by spinning like a propeller. Wind pollinated trees are of little interest to grazing birds or insects.
