# Mixing household bleach solution for sanitising 

Household bleach (4\% available chlorine) can be an inexpensive and effective sanitiser if mixed correctly

## TIPS FOR USING BLEACH

$\checkmark \quad$ Only use bleach that is still within the expiry date.
$\checkmark \quad$ Use bleach free from fragrances and other additives.
$\checkmark \quad$ Diluted bleach solutions should be made daily.
$\checkmark \quad$ Do not mix bleach with detergent.
$\sqrt{ } \quad$ Mix concentrated bleach into cold or warm water, it is safer to do so.
$\checkmark \quad$ If using spray bottles to store the mixed bleach solution ensure that it is clearly labelled.
$\checkmark \quad$ Rinse the bleach solution thoroughly with clean water to remove any chemical residue.
