Develops proteoid or cluster roots that help it extract phosphorus from nutrient poor soils.

- Green foliage with silvery under surface.
- Pale to bright yellow flowers

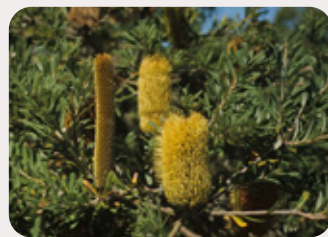
