- Lustrous, dark green leaves.
- Fragrant flowers in spring are yellow-cream-coloured.

TOLERANCES

- Frost tender.

ORIGIN

Upland rainforests NSW, QLD, New Guinea.

FACTS AND TRIVIA

A 'Monotypic' genus meaning Native Frangipani is the only species belonging to Hymenosporum.

Nectar attracts butterflies and bees.

Strong honey fragrance of flowers bears resemblance to the aroma of frangipani, hence its common name.
