

HOW TO PLANT YOUR NEW TREE



1.

Place your index and middle finger either side of the stem and turn the plant upside down.



2.

Loosen the plant from the tube by squeezing the sides of the tube. Ensure not to pull the plant out by its stem!



3.

Carefully slide the tube off the plant and hold its root ball in your hand. It's time to plant!



4.

Dig a small hole that is slightly deeper than the depth of the tube.



5.

Carefully place the plant in the hole and backfill the soil. Make sure the top of root ball is slightly below the surface to allow a shallow bowl for water.



6.

Water the plant and add mulch to the surface. Ensure to leave a small gap between the stem and mulch.

ADDITIONAL TIPS

Water weekly during dry periods while the tree becomes established. This can take between 12 to 24 months.

Add a seaweed-based fertiliser in the initial watering to help promote healthy root growth and reduce initial planting shock.

The addition of mulch will help retain water and will protect the tree's roots from the hot summer sun. Just ensure not to pile the mulch up against the stem!
