Grant Focus

Sport and recreation grants will assist clubs in providing a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment for all. Including, but not limited to, increasing member engagement, retention of current members, re-engaging lapsed members and increasing participation for diverse members of the community.

It will also focus on implementing strategic directions for the club to ensure they are sustainable and that volunteers have the necessary resources and tools to effectively operate the club.

Priorities/Criteria

Applications must identify a need for the project in the community

Building Strong Communities - Work in partnership with and empower the community and other stakeholders to use sport and recreation to help build stronger and more resilient communities.

Access and Equity- Provide an accessible, equitable and inclusive approach to the provision of sport and recreation facilities and activities.

Sustainable Development - Focus on sustainable practices in the planning, development and delivery of sport and club programs.

Projects with a technology focus, which increase participant capacity in club activities or safety	
Items/proposals that are ineligible	
Infrastructure projects	Projects that fall outside of government restrictions
Operational/ongoing costs of a club	Projects not aligned with Council's values
Requests for capital items, this includes storage	Regular club activities e.g. presentation nights
solutions such as sheds or shipping containers.	
Costs relating to existing or previously completed	Funding of trophies, medals, drink bottles, honour boards
activities/projects	
Funding to upgrade kitchens and kitchen equipment	Funding for scholarships or programs to cover player fees
