A Sports Fields
New irrigation and drainage to be installed throughout all sports fields as part of the storm water harvesting project.

- A1 Main cricket field (turf centre wicket).
- A2 No. 2 cricket field.
- A3 Relocate the three cricket practice nets.
- A4 Main outer soccer field.
- A5 Retain the enclosed soccer field but reduce dimensions to 105m long x 68m wide.
- A6 Install a low level grass spectator berm along the sideline.
- A7 Remove existing fence and install 2 new north-south orientated soccer fields.

- B Sports Pavilion**
- B1 Remove the existing sports pavilion and the Williamstown Soccer Club social rooms. Construct a new community sports pavilion.
 - B2 Install a paved forecourt around the pavilion.
 - B3 New turf wicket maintenance shed and cricket store.

- C Other Recreational Features**
Install interpretive signage at various locations around the reserve.
- C1 New Birdie Cage (an enclosed golf practice tee).
 - C2 New landscaped area with BBQ and shelter.
 - C3 Realign the shared path and install pedestrian barrier between path and road.
 - C4 Realign shared path
 - C5 Rest Stop: picnic shelter, and 2-3 interactive art elements.
 - C6 Spectator shelter.
 - C7 Future shared path along Maddox Rd north
 - C8 New unsealed path

- D Traffic Management**
- D1 New signalled intersection.
 - D2 Main vehicle entry into the reserve (sealed).
 - D3 Asphalt, line mark and extend the existing car park (128 spaces).
 - D4 New car park (75 spaces) with turnaround circle (double spray sealed).
 - D5 Install crush rock surfaced indented parking in Maddox Road to service the outer fields (40 spaces).
 - D6 Investigate construction of a median break.
