- Explore the viability of Cherry Lake for recreational use. This will involve a partnership between HBCC, Melbourne Water and City West Water to undertake feasibility work into water quality, future access to the water and any associated developments.
- Instigate a tree planting program to increase numbers of indigenous trees and to increase natural shade within the Sports Precinct, while maintaining important view lines
- Investigate providing a safe pedestrian link to Cherry Lake across Millers Road.
- Develop a multi-purpose recreational area adjacent to the Millers Road entry, to appropriately service personal trainers and sporting clubs needs for grassed informal training surfaces, as well as general recreational use (eg. kick-about area). Provide timed lighting, drinking fountains, rubbish bins and seating. Consider opportunities to provide for storage of Lions Club equipment.
- Improve the car parking facilities including resurfacing, lighting and reconfigured car parking.
- Explore the feasibility of constructing and operating a kiosk/cafe. Feasibility study to include its viability, potential location, size of enterprise, scope of facility etc.
- Potential site for accessible jetty, viewing platform, and future ramp for non-powered boats.
- Upgrade playground to an accessible play space. Consider providing timed lighting. Upgrade the surrounding landscape and incorporate canopy trees to provide natural shade, particularly on the western side of the playground.
- Provide timed lighting to the BBQ/Picnic area, playspace, Sensory Garden, Cherry Lake reserve and associated paths to enable use by families in the early evenings.
- Provide distance markers to the existing circuit path to Cherry Lake. Provide interpretive signage on wildlife, vegetation and history. Discuss with Melbourne Water the modification of planting where it encroaches on the path, particularly along northern shoreline. Provide linkages to the Kororoit Creek Trail, the proposed wetlands at the western inlet to Cherry Lake and the proposed viewing platform.
- Add security lighting where appropriate throughout the precinct.
