REMOVE ALL LIDS & CORKS (PUT THESE IN THE RUBBISH) RINSE EMPTY JARS AND BOTTLES

COLLECTED EVERY FOUR WEEKS

What can go in?

FOOD WASTE CAN BE WRAPPED IN A SHEET OF NEWSPAPER OR PAPER TOWEL BEFORE BEING PLACED IN THE GREEN LID BIN

CITRUS, ONIONS

& GARLIC

EGGSHELLS & DAIRY

(NO CONTAINERS)



MEAT, SEAFOOD & BONES (COOKED & RAW)

PLASTIC BAGS AND THEIR CONTENTS GO TO LANDFILL. TO RECYCLE YOUR FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE, KEEP IT OUT OF PLASTIC BAGS.

MIXED RECYCLING: PLASTICS, PAPER, CARDBOARD, METALS

PLASTICS CODE 1 (PET OR PETE), CODE 2 (HDPE) AND CODE 5 (PP)



PAPER: NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, FLYERS, CATALOGUES, OFFICE PAPER AND ENVELOPES



ALUMINIUM AND STEEL: CANS AND TINS, AND FOIL (IN 10CM-DIAMETER BALLS)



CARDBOARD: UNWAXED BOXES AND CARTONS
