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Grant Focus

Neighbourhood resilience and strength grants support activities that foster or respond to the strength in a particular area, building local connections, celebrating the community, strengthening support frameworks, building awareness of local services and providing opportunities to reduce isolation and loneliness.

Priorities/Criteria

- Build local leadership
- Local connection
- Opportunities for social and economic participation
- · Celebrate and build on local strengths
- Invest in local assets
- Gather interest and start work on an area or topic that requires attention

Example applications/proposals

Elements of a strong application:

- Community need demonstrated
- Community engaged already
- Supports strong connection building
- Harnesses community energy
- Encourages participation a people project
- Engages businesses or contractors to support achieving the community outcomes
- Partnerships exist or will be built through the project. These may work in partnership with other areas, such as festivals, sport, youth, music, performance
