Appropriate for Prep through to Grade 4

Short session – 1 block (45-50 mins)

Introduction

- Story book: No more plastic by Alma Fullerton
- Discussion of key themes: environment, waste, sustainability, animal life, activism

Beyond the bin

- · Video: Where does my recycling go?
- What we can do to help the planet
- Interactive class activity: Which bin?

Conclusion

Long session – 2 blocks (90-100 mins)
