

Woods Street Youth Art Prize 2022

Terms & Conditions

- All entrants must be between 14 and 25 years old.
- Young artists who study, live, work, reside or have a connection to the inner and Western suburbs of Melbourne from the Cities of Hobsons Bay, Maribyrnong, Brimbank, Melton, Moonee Valley, Geelong, or Melbourne are eligible to submit.
- A maximum of 2 artworks can be submitted except if the artwork is a diptych or triptych.
- We encourage a diversity of mediums, including film, projections, performance art and sculptural as well as two-dimensional artworks.
- The deadline for entries is **3pm Monday 12 September 2022**. No entries will be accepted after this time.
- Artworks need to be physically dropped off to Woods Street Arts Space, 44 Woods Street Laverton
- All artworks need to be clearly labelled with artists name and title on the back of the work.
- To the best of artist knowledge, the work must not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libellous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content. Any work that breaches this, will not be exhibited
- There will be a prize specific for Hobsons Bay Artists
- The judges' decision is final and there will be no further correspondence entered into.
- All two-dimensional (2D) artworks MUST be delivered with a hanging system on the rear of the artwork, please note we do NOT provide frames for artworks.
- If the artwork is a three-dimensional (3D) artwork, sculpture, performance artist, film or large format photograph and has special installation requirements please stipulate on the form. Please be aware that we may require the artist to assist with technical requirements for the installation of the artwork.
- Performance artists must be available for judging and available for the launch and exhibition period
- Artworks need to be collected at the conclusion of the exhibition Uncollected works may be disposed of if they remain uncollected after this time and no communication has occurred.
- The launch and Award Ceremony event will be held 6pm to 8pm, Friday 11 November 2022. Artists are encouraged to be present to accept awards and support their fellow artists.
- Council reserves the right to use photographs of the artworks submitted, ensuring artists are credited for the sole purpose of marketing and promotion of the event, prior, during and after.
- By entering the artwork into this exhibition, the artists agrees that their work may potentially be reproduced and exhibited on the Airtime Flags at Altona Meadows Skate Park Artists will be notified and acknowledged for their artwork.
- Hobsons Bay City Council will not accept responsibility for damage to artworks either before, during or after the exhibition if they are not prepared to be suitable for exhibiting.
- As exhibition space is limited applications will go through a selection process to assess if they will be included in the exhibition.
- The valuation of the artwork(s) must be in line with the recent sales history of the artist. If an insurance claim is made for loss, theft or damage, further valuation evidence will be required.
