Terms and Conditions

1. Hobsons Bay City Council recognises that the artist/s retain full ownership of **images submitted**.
2. By submitting work, artists agree that if selected, Hobsons Bay City Council is permitted to use images of artwork.
3. A maximum of one application can be submitted for the exhibition program by an applicant.
4. Artist agrees to not exhibit the work anywhere else during the selected exhibition period without prior discussion with Hobsons Bay City Council.
5. All entries will be reviewed by a selection panel. The decisions of the selection panel are final.
6. Artists confirm they are the sole copyright owner and creator of the artwork.
7. Artist agrees to acknowledge anyone who has assisting in making of the work.
8. Artist confirms that they have been granted permission for anyone portrayed in the artwork.
9. To the best of artist/s knowledge, the work must not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libellous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content. Any work that breaches this, will not be exhibited and no artists fee paid.
10. Hobsons Bay City Council reserves the rights to make decisions on final works exhibited, based on suitability of work for public space.
11. Hobsons Bay City Council has the right to use artist's name and image for promotion and publicity including but not limited to Hobsons Bay City Council website, newsletters, printed promotional materials, press releases, social media and distribution to press outlets.
12. Artists may undertake their own marketing and publicity but only in consultation with Hobsons Bay City Council representatives and in line with Hobsons Bay City Council's style guide. Any additional marketing undertaken outside of Hobsons Bay City Council's marketing is at the artist/s expense.
13. The artwork may remain displayed for a period longer than originally agreed upon in writing.
14. Hobsons Bay City Council may choose to invite the artist to facilitate a public program to coincide with their exhibition. If an artist is invited to, they will be paid as per NAVA rates or as negotiated.
15. Hobsons Bay City Council will cover the cost of approved public programming. Hobsons Bay City Council is not responsible for budget shortfalls if the recipient is unable to meet project costs.
